REPORT OF THE COUNCIL OF MANAGEMENT FOR THE YEAR 2017-18

An account of the activities of Forum of Free Enterprise during 2017-18 is given below:

I. Booklets

II. Public Meetings

a) The Forum associated itself with Nani A. Palkhivala Memorial Trust in arranging the 14th and 15th Nani A. Palkhivala Memorial Lectures during the year. While the 14th Memorial Lecture was delivered by Mrs. Arundhati Bhattacharya, the then Chairman, State Bank of India, on "How Can Bank Mergers Lead to Stakeholder Value Creation?" on 22nd August 2017, the 15th Memorial Lecture was delivered by Dr. Kaushik Basu, Former Chief Economic Adviser, Govt. of India and presently C. Marks Professor, Cornell University on "Law, Economics and the Control of Corruption" on 14th December 2017. Both the lectures were arranged at the Y.B. Chavan Centre Auditorium, Mumbai.

On the occasion of the 15th Memorial Lecture the Trust also presented *Nani A. Palkhivala Award for Protection and Preservation of Civil Liberties and Human Rights* to **Mr. Fali Sam Nariman**, eminent jurist, in recognition of his outstanding contribution to human rights and civil liberties. The Award was presented at the hands of **Mrs. (Justice) Sujata Manohar**, (Retd.), Former Judge, Supreme Court of India.

- b) The 29th Bhogilal Leherchand Memorial Lecture was delivered by Dr. Abhay Bang, Founder & Director, SEARCH – Society for Education, Action and Research in Community Health, Gadchiroli, Maharashtra on "In Search of Ethical, Equitable and Effective Health Care for India" on 4th December 2017 at Seth Walchand Hirachand Hall, IMC Chamber of Commerce & Industry premises (IMC), Churchgate, Mumbai.
- c) One of the highlights of the year's public meetings was the huge success of the meeting addressed by **Mr. H.P. Ranina** on "The Union Budget 2018-19" on 1st February 2018 at Patkar Hall, New Marine Lines, Mumbai. The venue was jam packed and the large audience, mainly comprising college and management students and faculty members, gave a spontaneous standing ovation to Mr. Ranina for his brilliant analysis of the subject. Just to recall that Mr. Ranina took over from Mr. Minoo R. Shroff as President of Forum of Free Enterprise and as Chairman and Managing Trustee of The A.D. Shroff Memorial Trust in February 2017. Besides, he is also a Founder-Trustee of Nani A. Palkhivala Memorial Trust.
- d) Public meetings on 'The Union Budget 2018-19' were also arranged in Borivli and Ghatkopar, suburbs of Mumbai, and in a management institute, jointly with a few other organizations, in early February 2018. The experts involved in the public meetings were: Dr. B.K. Bhoi, Dr. Brinda Jagirdar, C.A. Mehul Shah, C.A. Namrata Dedhia, C.A. Rajiv Luthia, Ms. Sarika Rachuri and C.A. Saroj Maniar.

III. The 13th M.R. Pai Memorial Award Function

Forum associated with All-India Bank Depositors' Association in arranging the **13th M.R. Pai Memorial Award Function**. The Award, instituted by Punjab and Maharashtra Cooperative Bank Ltd. in 2004, was presented to **Mr. A.P. Hota**, Ex-Managing Director & CEO, National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) on 21st August 2017 at IMC, Churchgate, Mumbai, for his **outstanding contribution to the citizens in the field of digitization of payment systems**.

IV. Youth Activities

Annual Youth Day

Every year Forum arranges the Annual Youth Day in which the best speakers in the three Elocution Competitions namely, The 53rd A.D. Shroff Memorial Elocution Competition for College Students, The 14th M.R. Pai Memorial Elocution Competition for School Students and The 14th Nani A. Palkhivala Memorial Elocution Contest for Law Students, chosen at the respective selection rounds, participate.

This year's Annual Youth Day arranged on Sunday, 28th January 2018 also at IMC, was a huge success. On the occasion Mr. Y.H. Malegam, Chairman, Nani A. Palkhivala Memorial Trust spoke about the life and work of the late Mr. Nani A. Palkhivala. Mr. Kanu H. Doshi, Member of Forum's Council of Management for over two decades, conducted the entire programme, whilst Mrs. Bhavna Doshi, Member of Forum's Council, inaugurated and introduced to the audience Forum's new YouTube Channel. More details of the respective competitions are given below:

The 53rd A.D. Shroff Memorial Elocution Competitions for College Students:

A total of 148 competitions were held in 87 places in 13 states during the year. (The list is appended to the report). Students were free to choose and speak on any one of the following subjects for five minutes each:

- A. Digitization The Way Forward;
- B. Importance of Infrastructure in Economic Development;
- C. Ethics in Business & Industry;
- D. Role of Youth in Building a New India.

The three best speakers were awarded cash prizes in each competition. More than 2000 students from over 170 colleges in the country participated in the competition. In most of the places outside Mumbai, the competitions were held by colleges for their own students, while in a few places inter-collegiate contests were held with the help of local organizations.

In Mumbai the competition was first held in 41 colleges. Later, the eight best among first-prize winners in these colleges were chosen for participation in the annual inter-collegiate contest. The eight students captivated the large audience with brilliant performances. The First Prize (Rs.10,000/-) was won by **Mr. Anurag Jha** of K.C. College of Arts, Commerce & Science, Churchgate; the Second Prize (Rs.7,500/-) by **Ms. Shalinita lyer** of Narsee Monjee College of Commerce & Economics, Vile Parle and the Third Prize (Rs.5,000/-) by **Ms. Simran Thakker** of R.A. Podar College of Commerce & Economics, Matunga.

The performance was judged by a panel comprising: **Dr. B.K. Bhoi**, Former Principal Advisor, Reserve Bank of India; **Mrs. Jer Dhondy**, Advisor, ACC Limited; and **Ms. Aparna Sivakumar**, Social Entrepreneur.

This competition is being conducted by The A.D. Shroff Memorial Trust and Forum of Free Enterprise since 1965 with the objective of encouraging college students to think and speak on economic subjects, besides enabling them to show their platform skills.

The 14th M.R. Pai Memorial Elocution Competition for School Students:

The competition is being held since 2004 by Forum and M.R. Pai Foundation. During 2017-18, it was held in 71 schools (list attached) in Mumbai, Thane, Vasai and Virar. More than 800 students from these schools participated. The authorities in each school deserve to be acclaimed for the encouragement given to their students to showcase their speaking talents on such a platform. The students were free to choose and speak on any one of the following subjects for five minutes each:

A. My Role Model in Society;

B. Challenges of Planning a Career / Exploring Opportunities in Career Planning.

The three best speakers in each school were awarded cash prizes. Later, the first-prize winners in these schools were invited to a selection round when the best nine from among them were chosen for participation in the annual inter-school contest. The performance of the chosen nine in the contest was greatly appreciated and applauded by the audience.

The First Prize (Rs.10,000/-) was won by **Ms. Shashwati Deshmukh** of B.A.F. Petit Girls' High School, Bandra; the Second Prize (Rs.7,500/) by **Mr. Varun Bhagtani** of Dr. S. Radhakrishnan Vidyalaya, Borivli and the Third Prize (Rs.5,000/-) by **Mr. Bhavya Shah** of Gopi Birla Memorial School, Walkeshwar.

The performance was judged by a panel comprising:

Mr. Narayan Pasari, President, Bombay Chartered Accountants' Society; **Ms. Pooja Seksaria**, Chartered Accountant, Deputy Manager, Deloitte Haskins & Sells Ltd; and **Mr. Sharad Seksaria**, Director-Finance, Taxation, Legal & Compliance, Watch Tower Group.

The 14th Nani A. Palkhivala Memorial Elocution Contest for Law Students:

Nani A. Palkhivala Memorial inter-collegiate contests were held in Mumbai, Pune and Thanjavur. In Pune, it was arranged by Symbiosis Law School; in Thanjavur by Sastra University and in Mumbai by Nani A. Palkhivala Memorial Trust jointly with Forum of Free Enterprise. In all places, the participants were free to choose and speak on any one of the following subjects for five minutes each:

- A. Law of Criminal Defamation its validity under the Constitution of India?;
- B. Do Indian Courts deliver Justice or are merely Forums Implementing Rule of Law?;
- C. Alternate Dispute Resolution (ADR) mechanisms in India Do they deliver?

The three best speakers were awarded cash prizes in each contest. In the inter-collegiate contest held in Mumbai, the First Prize (Rs.10,000/-) was awarded to **Ms. Harsha Menon** of Vivekananda Education Society's College of Law, Chembur; the Second Prize (Rs.7,500/-) to **Mr. Divej Singh Rana** of SVKM's Pravin Gandhi College of Law, Vile Parle and the Third Prize (Rs.5,000/-) to **Ms. Palak Gupta** of V.P.M.'s TMC Law College, Thane.

The contest was judged by: **Col. Abhijit Kadam** (**Retd.**), Advocate; **Mr. Dyaneshwar Wagh**, Police Inspector and **Mr. Sunil Zalmi**, Partner, MZD Legal Consultancy. Incidentally, the three judges are recipients of Nani Palkhivala Gold Medal, instituted by Nani A. Palkhivala Memorial Trust, for securing the First Rank in the LL.M examination of their respective universities.

Leadership Training Camps:

A total of 55 Leadership Training Camps for the youth were arranged during the year. Fifty-four of these were two-day camps in different locations covering eight states, and a Union Territory while one was a five-day residential camp, in Lonavla. These camps were arranged jointly with M.R. Pai Foundation. In these camps over 4000 boys and girls participated and greatly benefitted from the highly interactive and motivational sessions conducted by a very dedicated team of expert trainers. The subjects on which sessions were conducted included: Goal Setting, Self Esteem, Effective Communication, Team Work, Time Management and Self- Management. The faculty for the camps included: **Mr. Animesh Gupta**, **Mrs. Clarissa Jathanna**, **Dr. Gowri Joshi**, **Mr. Rajiv Luv**, **Mr. Sachin Kamath**, **Ms. Shruti Juyal and Mr. Vivek Patki**.

The places where the two-day camps were conducted are: Eluru, Guntur, Vijayawada (**A.P**.); Bambolim, Margao (**Goa**); Anand, Bhavnagar, Jamnagar, Morbi, Pardi, Rajkot, Surat, Vallabh Vidyanagar, Vapi (**Gujarat**); Yamunanagar (**Haryana**); Belgaum, Benjanapadauv, Bhatkal, Gonikoppal, Karkala, Kumta, Madikeri, Manipal, Moodbidri, Mulki, Mysore, Nitte, Polibetta, Saragur, Shimoga, Thokur, Ujire (**Karnataka**); Baramati, Jalna, Kolhapur, Lonavala, Magarpatta, Talasari, Wai (**Maharashtra**); Chandigarh, (**U.T.**); Mohali (**Punjab**); Chennai, Kanchipuram, Trichy (**T.N**.).

In the residential camp held at Lonavla 36 boys and girls, all in the age group of 20 to 22 years, from different places, participated. The theme of the camp was "*Breaking Barriers*".

CA Raman Jokhakar, Member, Council of Management, Forum of Free Enterprise inaugurated the camp, addressed and interacted with the participants. Mr. Vivek Patki, Program Director along with other experts, namely, Mr. Ajit Kamath, Dr. Arati Nayak, Mrs. Clarissa Jathanna, Mr. Rajiv Luv, Mr. Sachin Kamath and Mr. Yateen Gharat conducted the sessions over the five days. Harish Shetty, well-known psychiatrist, Dr. conducted a session on "Overcoming Emotional **Barriers**" for the benefit of the group.

The feedback from the participants in all the camps has continued to remain heart-warming and encouraging.

Career Guidance Session:

A Career Guidance Session for students was conducted by **Miss Shailaja Mulay** jointly with M.R. Pai Foundation and Borivli Sanskrutik Kendra.

V. Other Activities

Engaging Pedagogies in Teaching:

For the benefit of the teaching faculty, a two-day workshop on '*Engaging Pedagogies in Teaching*' was arranged at **Badrinarayan Barwale College**, Jalna, Maharashtra was conducted by **Dr. Gowri Joshi**. The feedback from the participants was excellent.

Workshop for Teachers:

A workshop for teachers of **New Era Public School**, Morbi, Gujarat was also arranged and conducted by **Mr. Vivek Patki & Mr. Sachin Kamath**. The management expressed gratitude for introducing some new teaching techniques to their teachers, who also participated enthusiastically.

VI. Program on Taxation

Mr. Raamdeo Agrawal, Jt. Managing Director, Motilal Oswal Securities Ltd., inaugurated the annual program for chartered accountants, company executives and others on "**Current Issues in Direct Taxation, Indirect Taxation and Service Tax**" held at Khandala. **Mr. Pinakin Desai** was Program Director and the other experts on the panel were: **Mrs. Bhavna Doshi, Mr. Kanu H. Doshi, Mr. Rajan Vora, Mr. T.P. Ostwal** and **Mr. Yogesh Thar**.

During the program, **Mr. Jhankar Gadkari**, interacted with the participants on "**Emotional Intelligence**".

The program was well-received by the participating professionals and company executives.

VII. Formation of Sub-Committee

At the Council meeting in November 2017, a Sub-Committee was formed to discuss the future plan and scope of Forum's activities. The Committee would take active participation in creating Forum's presence in the digital space.

The Committee met a couple of times and later stayed connected through regular conference calls and continued to contribute in different ways. The first initiative was to launch Forum's YouTube channel.

- c) The Bhogilal Leherchand Memorial lecture by Dr. Abhay Bang and Nani A. Palkhivala Memorial lecture by Dr. Kaushik Basu, both held in December 2017, have been uploaded on the Channel.
- d) The talk on "The Union Budget 2018-19" delivered by Mr. H.P. Ranina, on 1st February 2018 at Patkar Hall, Mumbai, is also available on the Channel.
- e) Speeches of all the 22 participants at Forum's Annual Youth Day are also uploaded on the Channel.

VIII. Finances

managed in a satisfactory manner as reflected in the circulated audited accounts for the year ended 31st March 2018.

IX. Mr. S. Divakara bids farewell

Mr. S. Divakara, Director-General, Forum of Free Enterprise, retired from service on 31st August 2017, after being associated with the Forum for over five decades.

Mr. Divakara joined Forum as the Assistant Secretary of its Bangalore Centre in 1964. After working there till 1970 he left Forum and took up other assignments in Bombay and in Goa during 1971-1978, although he continued his association with Forum through organizing its activities in Bangalore, Goa, Visakhapatnam other places. On 2nd January 1979 he rejoined Forum as its Secretary in Bombay.

In January 2004, Mr. Divakara was re-designated, as Director-General of Forum. Again in August 2015 he was re-designated as Director-General of Nani A. Palkhivala Memorial Trust, Forum of Free Enterprise and The A.D. Shroff Memorial Trust. He was also Member-Secretary and Trustee of M.R. Pai Foundation founded in 2004. He retired from all these organizations on 31st August 2017.

A function was organized on 31st August 2017 to bid farewell to Mr. Divakara when Mrs. Swati Kapadia, Director till then, was appointed his successor as the CEO of all the above four organizations.


CA G. NARAYANASWAMY

In his book titled '*Beyond Auditing*', there is a mention of his sentiments and connections with Forum, which read as below:





Mr. Vyas was elected to the Council of Management of Forum on 16th October 1981 and remained on the Council till his passing away. For several years, he addressed Forum's public meetings on the Union Budget in Mumbai and other places and was also a regular speaker at its residential programs for senior company executives across the country.

May his soul rest in peace!
