#### REPORT OF THE COUNCIL OF MANAGEMENT FOR THE YEAR 2021-22

For a second year, i.e. during F.Y. 2021-22, the activities of Forum of Free Enterprise were conducted on a limited scale on account of the pandemic. An account is given below:

#### I. Booklets

Booklets listed below, were published and distributed free.

#### **II. Youth Activities**

#### **Virtual Leadership Training Programs:**

The late M. R. Pai, one of the builders of Forum, took keen interest in encouraging and mentoring students with the object of making them well-informed citizens. As its flagship program, the M. R. Pai Foundation jointly with Forum have been arranging leadership training camps in his memory, for school and college students across the country. During the year, 27 virtual leadership training programs and 1 offline program for the youth were arranged in seven states. Around 2000 boys and girls participated and benefitted from the contents and interactions in the sessions conducted by a team of distinguished trainers. The subjects were: Setting & Achieving Goals, Sharpening Vital Skills, The Power of Habits, Understanding Self & Others. The faculty for the camps included: Mrs. Clarissa Jathanna, Mr. Rajiv Kumar Luv, Mr. Sachin Kamath and Mr. Vivek Patki.

The institutions for which these programs were conducted were located at Eluru, Vijayawada (A.P.); Cujira (Goa); Anand, Bhavnagar, Surat, Vapi (Gujarat); Kaithal, Yamunanagar (Haryana); Belagavi, Kumta, Mulki, Mysuru, Nitte, Shivamogga, Ujire (Karnataka); Baramati, Kolhapur, Mumbai, Pune, Solapur (Maharashtra); Chandigarh (Punjab).

The feedback from all the participants was excellent and heart-warming. Besides being relieved from the monotony and stress of the lockdowns and restrictions, the participants found the contents very beneficial and for which they expressed deep gratitude.

- c) A panel discussion on 'The Union Budget 2022-23' on 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2022 was also arranged. The panelists were Dr. B. K. Bhoi, Former Principal Advisor and Head of the Monetary Policy Department, Reserve Bank of India, CA Hitesh Gajaria, Senior Partner, Tax, KPMG India, and CA Sunil Gabhawalla, Partner, S. B. Gabhawalla & Co. and CA Raman Jokhakar, Partner, B. D. Jokhakar & Co. was Moderator of the program.
- d) The Forum, joined other organizations, in arranging another virtual meeting on 'Impact of Union Budget on Capital Market'. The speakers were: CA Kanu Doshi, Mr. Mehraboon Irani, Veteran Market Analyst and Mr. Jimeet Modi, Founder & CEO of SAMCO Group;

The webinars were attended by a large number of persons, particularly by professors and students and were very interactive.
